## Nominations for Reading List 2010

## Criteria for Nomination

For a book to be eligible for selection on the WAYRBA Reading List it must be:

- Fiction/Non Fiction published or reprinted during the preceding 5 years (translations are acceptable)
- The author must be living
- Any author may have only one title on each list for that year
- Listed titles are excluded from the Award in subsequent years
