

Beginner's guide to WAYRBA

West Australian Young Readers' Book Award

WAYRBA is a children's choice award and is very simple to run.

1. Check out the shortlists at <https://wayrba.org.au> and purchase the titles suitable for your library.
2. Print out the voting forms.
3. Purchase some merchandise! Stickers help identify WAYRBA books in your collection, a poster makes an instant display and bookmarks help promote WAYRBA. The merchandise is designed by local artists and illustrators.
4. Collect student votes, enter them on the tally sheets and email them to WAYRBA at admin@wayrba.org.au (you don't need to send in the votes). Voting normally closes at the end of Term Three and winners are announced in Term Four.
5. Encourage students to nominate books they have enjoyed for next year's shortlist. Nominated books must be no older than five years, still in print and the author must be living. Send nominations to the committee.
